### Checklist:

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete the NJHS Candidate Form.

\_\_\_\_\_ Attach your previous year's report card and your 1<sup>st</sup> semester report card for this year (these can be found in HAC under transcripts).

**To be a member of NJHS, you must have a 3.75 or higher unweighted GPA, after at least one semester in attendance at the school.**

\_\_\_\_\_ Distribute Recommendation Forms to FIVE teachers.

- Be sure to *neatly* write your FIRST and LAST name, and your first period teacher, on each Recommendation Form **before** giving it to a teacher.
- Recommendation Forms will be returned directly to Mrs. Stofko.
- You must give these forms to a Middle School teacher (Elementary teachers will not be accepted).

\_\_\_\_\_ Distribute Recommendation Form to ONE community member that can verify your character or service in the community (example: coach, scout leader, somewhere you volunteer, your pastor etc.).

- Be sure to *neatly* write your FIRST and LAST name, and your first period teacher, on the Recommendation Form before giving it to a community member.
- This should be emailed back to me at [jayne.stofko@stjohns.k12.fl.us](mailto:jayne.stofko@stjohns.k12.fl.us) or put in a sealed envelope and returned to me with your application.

The above-mentioned requirements are due no later than **Friday, February 27<sup>th</sup> at 3:00PM**.

- ✓ Applicants will not be considered for membership unless all requirements are met by the due date (no exceptions-this lends itself to responsibility).
- ✓ Provide the required information to Mrs. Stofko in room 617.

New members will be notified via parent email account (indicated on the Candidate Form) no later than **Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>**.

At that time a check (made out to PVA) or \$20 cash in an envelope with your first and last name will need to be turned into Mrs. Stofko in room 617 for membership dues. If payment is not received prior to the date of inductions, you will not be able to be inducted into NJHS.

Membership in the Palm Valley Academy Middle School Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society is both an honor and a responsibility. Should you be invited for membership, you must demonstrate superior qualities of scholarship, service, leadership, and character. As a member in good standing, you will be expected to continue to demonstrate, develop, and strengthen these qualities through your participation in chapter service projects, activities, and meetings.

I. *Scholarship*

- Applicants must attach required report cards showing at least a 3.75 unweighted GPA.
- Applicants must demonstrate academic initiative and maintain at least a 3.75 GPA throughout the duration of membership.

II. *Service*

- Applicants are expected to participate in 4 service projects that will promote a form of charity for the school or local community.
- Applicants are expected to complete a minimum of 12 community/academic service hours a year (at least 3 in each quarter).

III. *Leadership*

- Applicants must demonstrate leadership in promoting school activities, contribute ideas that improve the civic life of the school, exemplify a positive attitude, be dependable, and be a role model for peers.
- Applicants must consistently uphold principles of morality, ethics, kindness, reliability, and trustworthiness. In addition, the applicant must agree to observe school rules and show courtesy, concern, and respect for others.

*Additional Responsibilities:*

- ✓ To enroll in and maintain a fully academic curriculum scheduled at PVA.
- ✓ To attend regular, special, and committee meetings.
- ✓ To participate in NJHS special projects.
- ✓ To actively demonstrate and develop qualities of leadership, service, and character.
- ✓ To pay annual dues, not to exceed \$20.
