The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring test that is administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards. Your student will take the K-2 Renaissance STAR assessments on the following administration dates:

Kindergarten	Early Literacy & Math	April 29 & April 30
First Grade	Reading & Math	April 27 & April 28
Second Grade	Reading & Math	April 21 & April 22

The results from PM3 will show how well your student has mastered the grade level content standards. You will be able to access the results on the family portal at <https://flfamilyportal.cambiumast.com> The access code can be found on HAC.

FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get less or more difficult depending on how your student responds, and each student will see different questions from a common item bank.
