Communication

Email is the preferred way of communication!

<u>Transportation Changes:</u> All transportation changes need to be documented on the appropriate form, sent in with your child, and will be submitted to the front office PRIOR to the 9 AM deadline.

• Last minute dismissal changes must be communicated through the front office, not through teacher email.

Various Procedures

Attendance: It is important that your child be in class every day that is possible. School begins at 8:40 AM and dismisses at 3:00 PM. Every Wednesday we have early release at 2:00pm.

<u>Tardiness:</u> A child is considered tardy after 8:40am.

Absence: Please send in a note with your child when returning to school following an illness. The office needs the excuse in writing for their records. Make up work will be given upon return.

Recess: Wear proper shoes each day.

Resource: Check weekly email for the schedule that week.

Medication: A form is required and may be obtained from the clinic website **HERE**

<u>Dress Code:</u> Please refer to page 14 of the Student Code of Conduct.



Various Procedures Cont.

<u>Excused Absences:</u> When your child is absent from school, please remember that our registrar must be notified via handwritten note or in email. Excuse notes can ONLY be accepted within 48 hours of a student returning to school, however, this does not necessarily mean the absence will be excused. Family vacations, birthday parties, shopping trips, suspension from school, and other avoidable absences are unexcused.

<u>Electronic Devices and Acceptable Use:</u> Electronic devices, including cell phones, smart phones, and smart watches should be OFF and AWAY during school hours, unless otherwise directed by an adult. Please refer to the district's Acceptable Use Policy or the Student Code of Conduct for more information.

<u>Transportation Changes:</u> All transportation changes need to be documented on the appropriate form (PVA website and below) and submitted to the front office PRIOR to the deadline.

- The testing window will open in April for Writing and May for Math and Reading.




Gradebook


Home Access Center (HAC) allows student and parents to view their child's educational information via a secure, password protected website.
