  - 6<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD/ADVANCED
  - 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STANDARD/ADVANCED/ ALGEBRA 1 HONORS
  - 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STANDARD/ADVANCED ALGEBRA 1 HONORS/GEOMETRY HONORS, PHYSICAL SCIENCE HONORS
- O ALL HIGH SCHOOL COURSES HAVE A STATE-DEVELOPED EOC WHICH IS 30% OF THEIR FINAL GRADE
- ALL 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STUDENTS WILL BE PLACED IN 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE STANDARD OR 6<sup>TH</sup> ADVANCED MATH BASED ON THEIR MATH FSA SCORES, AND FINAL MATH GRADES FROM 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

- ENROLLMENT IN ELECTIVES ARE NOT GUARANTEED, BUT BY USING THIS PROCESS, WE WILL BE ABLE TO OPEN SECTIONS BASED UPON DEMAND AND TEACHER CERTIFICATION.
- ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FOLLOWING:
  - PHYSICAL EDUCATION
  - COMPUTERS (CSD, ICT)
  - ELECTIVE OF CHOICE
- EXCEPTIONS ARE MADE ON A PER STUDENT BASIS

#### **COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS & CHANGE REQUESTS**

- IN APRIL, YOUR STUDENT WILL BRING HOME A COURSE VERIFICATION FORM THAT HAS THEIR 2022-2023 MIDDLE SCHOOL COURSE PLACEMENTS. YOUR STUDENT'S COURSE REQUESTS WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE IN HAC. THESE PLACEMENTS WILL BE BASED ON THE CULMINATION OF TEAM-DEVELOPED FORMATIVE AND SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS, IREADY DATA, PREVIOUS FSA SCORES, AND STUDENT PERFORMANCE IN THE CLASSROOM THROUGHOUT THIS SCHOOL YEAR.
