

Checklist for students with medical needs:

<u>New medical diagnosis, needs or alerts?</u> It is important that the school have up to date medical information. If you need to add anything to your student's health record, please send in a written note ("Attention: School Nurse") to be placed with your student's file.

Need to leave medication at school?

- 1. Download any forms from the PVA "Health Clinic" department webpage
- Bring the forms in to your pediatrician. A parent and doctor must sign the forms for them to be valid.
- Medications must be in their original container with a readable pharmacy/consumer label, unopened and unexpired. Please see our Medication Policy on the website for any further questions.

Dropping off supplies and medication? Bring your orders and supplies to the school during office hours to briefly meet with a nurse.

Reminder: It is a violation of the Student Code of Conduct for children to be carrying any medication (prescription or over the counter) with them at school without proper documentation. All medication must have a doctor's order on file in the clinic. Middle schoolers may carry over the counter medication *only with a signed form by the parent on file in the clinic.* Any violations will be brought up to Administration. Medication forms and more information can be found on the PVA Clinic Website.

Health Screenings K, 1st, 3rd, and 6th Grades:



Accidents happen: Food spills, mud puddles and more...



Transportation & Dismissal







- Anyone requesting transportation changes and early dismissals must fill out the online PVA Dismissal Change Form. For any transportation changes, please utilize the transportation change form on our website: <u>https://surveys.stjohns.k12.fl.us/</u> <u>TakeSurvey.aspx?SurveyID=m2MHIn92#</u> Dismissal changes can be made up to 12:00 PM the day of the change.
- Absentee form can be completed online at https://surveys.stjohns.k12.fl.us/

 <u>TakeSurvey.aspx?SurveyID=pvaabsentee#</u> This can be done INSTEAD of a paper form. No need to complete both. Either way is acceptable.
- PVA cannot write any bus passes. Any student that needs to ride to a location other than their assigned bus stop, will be required to complete a Provisional Transportation Waiver. For more information, please visit http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/transportation/ptwaiver/ This process is entirely online and controlled through the Transportation Department, not at the school level.
- The cutoff time for checking out a student early is 2:15 pm on M,T, Th, F and 1:15 pm on Wed. This is to ensure a smooth and safe dismissal for all. Please plan accordingly.
- The front office cannot call for a student to check out early until the parent/ guardian has physically arrived to sign them out. <u>Please have driver's license or</u> <u>state issued ID card with you when signing out student(s).</u>






PVA BOOK FAIR




Save the Date!
