Join the CHARACTER COUNTS! Steering Committee for its 10th Annual CHARACTER COUNTS! 6K/3K Run/Walk on Saturday, February 4, 2023, at 9 a.m. and help us celebrate "10 Years Running!" The run/walk will begin and end at Palencia Elementary School, located at 355 Palencia Village Drive, St. Augustine.

Walkers and runners will enjoy a course running through the neighborhoods of Kensington and Las Calinas and can choose to participate in the 6K (3.73 miles) or 3K (1.86 miles) distance.

Registration fees are as follows:

6K: \$35 January 1-February 2 \$40 on race day **3K**: \$30 January 1-February 2 \$35 on race day

Race proceeds support CHARACTER COUNTS! initiatives throughout the St. Johns County School District (SJCSD). The run/walk is open to all ages, and the top three winners will be awarded in each of the age categories as well as the overall male and female finishers. A cash donation will be awarded to the top three to five schools with the most registrants. At the finish line, each race participant will receive a finisher's medal.

This event is produced by the CHARACTER COUNTS! Steering Committee and is presented by Beaver Toyota with support from businesses and community groups. Action News Jax CBS47/FOX30 is the official media sponsor of this run/walk.

The SJCSD, along with area businesses, youth organizations and civic groups, selected the national character education program of CHARACTER COUNTS! as a countywide initiative to instill positive character traits in young people throughout the county. Additionally, the SJCSD became the first school district in Florida to implement Pursuing Victory With Honor in all of its athletic programs. Character education is an important part of every School Improvement Plan and a major component of the Student Code of Conduct and the school district's Strategic Plan.

MIDDLE SCHOOL NEWS

Middle School Parents,

Last month, I had the opportunity to start speaking with both 7th and 8th grade students about high school and career interests. I will continue these discussions in classes in December. Just as a reminder, students will utilize an online program called Naviance and they can share their progress with you at home.

If you are just starting to begin the high school registration process, here is some background. Students zoned for Palm Valley Academy will matriculate to Nease High School. There is the option to apply for a Program of Choice such as a Career Academy at schools not in your home zone. They can also apply for Academies at their home zone school. If you want to learn more about Programs of Choice and Career Academies, please visit https://cte.stjohns.k12.fl.us/programs/. Academies are a way for students to learn about a career interest and often obtain certifications in those fields through their elective courses in high school.

The online application for Programs of Choice will be a lottery opening you can enter through HAC and instructions will be sent by the district. Please note that the **Academies and Programs of Choice are all optional**. Transportation is only provided to your zoned school. No lottery completion is required if you plan to attend Nease High School and do not wish to enter an Academy or the IB Program.

Nease High School will also be visiting Palm Valley Academy this month to present students with information about Academies, JROTC, and the IB program. This event is for current 8th grade students only, but the school district posts a timeline here of events with opportunities for families to visit and learn about other schools. You are strongly encouraged to attend the High School Showcase with your child on December 14 at World Golf Village. Nease High School also offers an Academy Night on January 19.






