# NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION 2023-2024 OPENS TUESDAY MARCH 1, 2023

#### KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE

To enroll for Kindergarten, your child must be 5 on or before September 1st.

#### The following items are required to register your child:

- 1. Complete Online Registration: <a href="https://registration.powerschool.com/family/gosnap.aspx?action=34623&culture=en">https://registration.powerschool.com/family/gosnap.aspx?action=34623&culture=en</a>
- 2. Three proofs of residency (Mortgage Statement, Deed or lease agreement, utility bill, and one additional bill)
- 3. Birth Certificate
- 4. Florida DOH 680 Certificate of Immunization (out of state immunizations must be transferred to FL form)
- 5. Physical must be dated within one year of enrollment (can be from any state)
- 6. Final Report Card for school year 2022-2023 (1st 6th grades) showing grade promotion



## **Attention 6th Grade Parents**



The Tdap immunization is required for all 7th graders.

Proof of this immunization on the DH 680 Form can be brought to the front office, faxed (904-547-4205), or emailed to <a href="Mary.Dominguez@stjohns.k12.fl.us">Mary.Dominguez@stjohns.k12.fl.us</a> even if your student is still in 6th grade. Please do this as soon as your child receives their shot.

Per district policy, all 7th grade students are required to submit an updated Florida DH 680 form to include Tdap, prior to the start of 7th grade.

## If your student currently has medication in the clinic:

- Please make time to stop by to pick it up before the end of the school year.
- District policy does not allow for medication to remain in the school over the summer. It will be important for you to make arrangements to pick up your child's medication since medications may not go home with the student.
- Any medication left in the clinic after Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. will have to be discarded according to district policy.

### Paperwork for next year:

- · New medication forms must be completed every school year.
- Check your student's backpack for
- Starting in June, medical forms can be downloaded from the PVA Health Clinic Page (see link above).
- Paperwork is standardized across all St John's County Schools should your student be transferring to high school or another district school. If your child has a physical examination during the summer months, this is a good time to get these medical forms completed.

#### Testing Tip for May: Make sure to catch your Zzzzz's


