# Gifted Screener (2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Only)

Each year 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders across the county are administered a *Gifted Screener*. Our kiddos are scheduled to take this assessment in November. Please see the attachment for further information, including procedures for opting-out.

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### Upcoming State Mandated Curriculum (K-5)

Over the next couple of weeks and ongoing throughout the course of the year, our two Elementary School Counselors will be working their way through each classroom (K-5) and delivering instruction as part of new state legislation. The counselor's will be using Lauren's Kids **Safer**, **Smarter Schools** curriculum to fulfill the mandates. Developed by Loren's Kids alongside lifelong educators, abuse prevention experts, and developmental psychologists, with support and oversight from the Florida Department of Education and the University of Florida this Pre-Kindergarten through 12th Grade personal safety and abuse prevention program incorporates age-appropriate engaging videos and in-class activities to enable all children to effectively learn critical safety strategies, no matter their learning style. The curriculum is large enough that it will take two/three resource cycles to get through the entire content for all classes. The schedule is as follows:

Kindergarten: Oct 26 - Nov 13 | Jan 8 - Jan 25 | March 2 - March 28 First Grade: Nov 14 - Dec 4 | Jan 26 - Feb 12 | April 1 - April 17 Second Grade: Dec 5 - Dec 21 | Feb 13 - March 1 | April 18 - May 6

Third Grade: Dec 5 - Dec 21 | Feb 13 - March 1
Fourth Grade: Nov 14 - Dec 4 | Jan 26 - Feb 12
Fifth Grade: Oct 26 - Nov 13 | Jan 8 - Jan 25
