The St. Johns County Volunteer Application is an application for clearance to be on school campus. Whether you are attending a conference with the teacher in person, volunteering in the classroom/events, escorting your kindergartener to class on their first official day of school, volunteering in the lunchroom, joining us for a presentation/celebration, and/or attending a field trip, you must have completed the above form. This is a district policy with no exceptions.

ALL THINGS PTO!

PTO stands for Parent-Teacher Organization. The PTO consists of parents and teachers working together to support and enrich all students here at Palm Valley Academy. Our PTO supports school staff, helps promote student selfesteem, and assists efforts to solve school needs through volunteers and funding.
