INFO FOR ALL (K-8)

School Advisory Council Meeting – Tuesday, Sept. 3rd @ 4:00pm

SAC is a school-based group intended to represent the school, the community, and those persons closest to the students. The group shares responsibility for guiding the school toward continuous improvement. PVA's School Advisory Council meets on the first Tuesday of each month at 4:00pm in the library. Meetings usually last 30-45 minutes and are open to the community. Our first meeting is Tuesday, September 3rd @ 4:00pm in the library. Notes on the First Rainy Day Hold

A Dress-Code Reminder

As students get more and more comfortable with their peers and with the daily routine of school, there historically has been an increase in dress code violations. Please note that as a school we are aligned to the district dress code policies as defined in the Student Code of Conduct. However, the below reminders are relevant to what we are most commonly addressing. Please review with your students to try and reduce dress-code violations.

- All shoes, sandals, or other footwear of any kind MUST have a "back" (Slides/Slippers are not permitted).
- Shirts must cover the midriff area.
- Hats, hoods, or other headwear is not permitted.
- Pajama pants are not permitted.

Cell Phones/Smart Watches

It is a state mandate and SJCSD Policy that all cellphones and smartwatches are off and away during instructional blocks during the school day. Students may have phones/watches out upon arrival and dismissal, but they must be turned off and put away at all other times. The only exception to this is the middle school policy, which allows phones/watches to be on during transitions.

- Elementary (K-5): ALL Phones and Smart Watches are off and in their backpacks at all time.
- Middle School (6-8): Students will turn-off phones/watches and place in their backpacks, or in the teachers provided pocket chart, where they will stay until students are dismissed. Additionally, ONE EAR BUD may be used during arrival and dismissal, but off and away at any other point of the day. STUDENTS MAY NOT KEEP PHONES ON THEIR PERSON DURING INSTRUCTIONAL BLOCKS!


We kindly ask that parents continue to assist us in discussing appropriate cell phones use regarding restrooms, pictures/videos, and social media. We appreciate your support and understanding.
