A Message of Safety from Deputy Wilson (3 of 3)

Hello parents, guardians and friends of Bobcats! We are still in hurricane season, and I want to convey a few helpful hints for storm preparedness.

- Hand-crank radios are a great way to keep up to date with changing weather without batteries. Look for models which also have a "weather band" so you can always get the latest NOAA updates. (KHB39 -162.550, SAME CODE 012109 for SJC, 012031 for Duval)
- Keep your vehicle gas tank topped off or no less than ¾ tank as a storm starts heading this way. Lines are always long at the last minute. Get an emergency first aid kit to keep in your vehicle. If you have a truck, keep a tow strap and a moving blanket handy under the back seat.
- Non-perishable food items are great to stock up on, well before the threat is imminent. Consider freeze-dried "bug out rations" too. Many companies offer containers of food about the size of a 5-gallon bucket, which can feed a family for up to 72 hours.
- Fill your bathtubs with water before the power goes out and water treatment plants go offline.
- Never run your generator indoors or within 20' of your eaves or garage opening. Carbon monoxide gas is odorless and poisonous.



PVA Band Boosters Spirit Night @ THE LOOP!


