We are thrilled to share that we have an exciting opportunity for our students and school community! Tomorrow, 3/24 we will be welcoming John Halligan, a distinguished national speaker, to speak with our 7th and 8th Grade Students during the day and ALL parents in the evening about the impact of bullying, cyberbullying and youth mental health.

Mr. Halligan suffered the devastating loss of his son, Ryan, to suicide in 2003. Ryan was a victim of bullying both at his middle school and online. Since 2005, when he first shared his son's story, Mr. Halligan has spoken at over 2000 schools throughout the United States, Canada and Mexico, impacting more than 1 million students. His message is both inspiring and educational and directly aligns with our commitment to providing meaningful learning experiences that extend beyond the classroom.

A Note of Safety from Deputy Wilson

Our safety patrollers have been handing out "Helmet Tickets" recently, which are redeemable for PBIS points. If your child has been spotted wearing their helmet, KUDOS!! Let's keep up the good work. 100% is our goal.

While our kiddos are out of school this week and there are so many fun things going on, please remember these safety reminders:

GOLF CARTS - May not be operated by any middle school or elementary child. Florida Statute 316.212 (7)(a) states no person shall operate a golf cart under the age of 18 unless they possess a valid learner's or operator permit.

E-BIKES - Florida statute 316.2065 mandates that all bicycle riders under the age of 16 wear a properly fitted helmet which meets federal safety standards. If your e-bike is capable of speeds over 20mph it is highly recommended to wear a helmet which would be suitable for a motorcycle. https://www.cyclingnews.com/features/best-electric-bike-helmets/



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






















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
