Grocery Items Non-perishable food items (canned proteins like peanut butter or tuna, canned veggies and fruits, boxed meals, box potatoes, macaroni & cheese, jelly, cereal, pop tarts, kid's snacks

Baby/Kid Items Diapers (preferably size 3 and up) baby food and any type of formula, NEW children's underwear & socks

Linens: XL twin sheets, towels

Office Supplies-paper, pens & pencils, spiral notebooks, stamps

Cleaning Supplies - household cleaning supplies and paper products (paper plates, napkins, toilet paper, paper towels, plastic silverware

Please note: Shelters do not have the space capacity to accept used clothing, shoes or stuffed animals
























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
