A Note of Safety From Deputy Wilson

Hey Parents and Friends of Bobcats near and far! A few reminders below!

- > I'm happy to see the increase in helmet usage by our Bobcats however, we still have many friends without.
- Please remind your students to wear their helmet properly and always, while operating their bike or scooter.
- If you are a golf cart operator transporting students to school, please remember the golf cart is considered a vehicle when operated on a public right of way. If your passenger falls into a category defined by NHTSA, they must be in an approved car seat or booster seat. Infants must NOT be in a cloth carrier strapped onto your body.
- > Seat belts must be in use for the operator and each passenger. Additionally cellphones must be in hands-free mode once you cross the bridge and enter the "school zone".


